Demographics Tip Sheet

Method used to determine demographic makeup of participants

- 1. **Actual Count** Participants were actually counted by the educator or participants completed an adult demographic form themselves (self-reported data)
- 2. Estimated Count All other methods used to count the participants including CDE Data

Source of Data

- 1. **Commercial market data on audience size** radio or television reach, supermarket reach or data on number of patrons in a specific amount of time
- 2. Survey of target audience adult demographic card
- Visual estimate Only counting participants and using the target audience age as the
 estimated age range. All other fields would be <u>unknown</u> for participants that do not
 wish to complete a demographic card. <u>Do not</u> visually assign demographics to any
 participant.
- 4. **Other** to be used when there is no demographics for the site and you are unable to get demographics from **DataQuest** or **Census data** or from the **site**. Please type, "no demographics available" in the text field.

Auto Calculate

When using the "Auto Calculate" button the **Method** will default to Estimated Count and the **Source** of Data will auto populate as "Site-provided demographics." **Do not change these**.
