# Re-opening Plan: Nutrition Program Specifics

[Additional guidance for Nutrition Education Program](#) (COVID-19 Phase 2 Information 9/11/20) - document is being retired

Review your county's **COVID-19 Prevention Plan** (CPP):

- Mask procedures, distancing procedures in office

- \* Educators should wear a mask to teach classes in-person

- Meeting procedures

- Outdoor activities

- Local travel using shared vehicle

Considerations for food activities:

- Choose recipes with minimal preparation steps when possible

- Pre-portion samples into covered portion cups when possible

- Distribute samples without participant contact

# Re-opening Plan: Other Considerations

Follow whatever procedures are stricter:

- UC/UC-ANR
- Local guidelines (county/city)
- School or community site

# Scenario 1

Your county's COVID-19 Prevention Plan (CPP) does not require fully vaccinated staff to wear a mask. You are fully vaccinated.

You are invited to teach in-person in a school classroom. School policy and local health policy require masks to be worn by staff and students while indoors (or outdoors if within 6 feet of distance).

## **What should you do?**

- A) Wear a mask
- B) Wear a mask only if you are within 6 feet of another person
- C) Don't wear a mask – inform the principal and the teacher that your employer doesn't require you to wear a mask

# Scenario 2

Your county's COVID-19 Prevention Plan (CPP) does not require fully vaccinated staff to wear a mask. You are fully vaccinated.

You are invited to teach an adult class at a community agency. The agency's procedures and local health guidelines do not require fully vaccinated individuals to wear masks.

**What should you do?**

- A) Don't wear a mask
- B) Wear a mask yourself but do not ask participants to wear masks
- C) Wear a mask and insist that participants also wear masks
- D) Wear a mask only if you are within 6 feet of another person

# Scenario 3

You are teaching an adult class at a community agency. You are following all UCANR and agency COVID-19 prevention guidelines.

You plan to ask class participants to prepare one recipe together by prepping ingredients at 'stations' – one task per station.

# Scenario 3

One participant per station

Set up stations 6 feet apart

Educator to distribute all food and supplies to each station

Utensils/equipment should not be shared between participants

Educator to portion samples and distribute without contact

Participants leave equipment at stations for educator to collect for washing and sanitizing

# Re-opening Plan: Other Considerations

County clusters – follow the plan specific to the county in which the activity takes place

You may *choose* to continue to wear a mask and practice social distancing even if no longer mandated

In-State travel – no longer restricted as to distance

Follow all safety procedures for shared vehicles, public transit

Keep yourself and others safe!

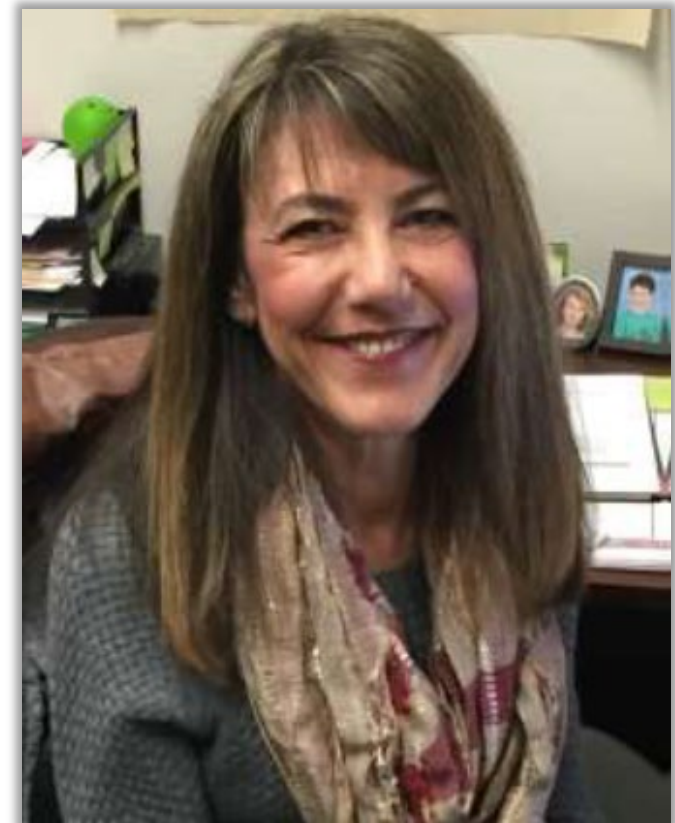

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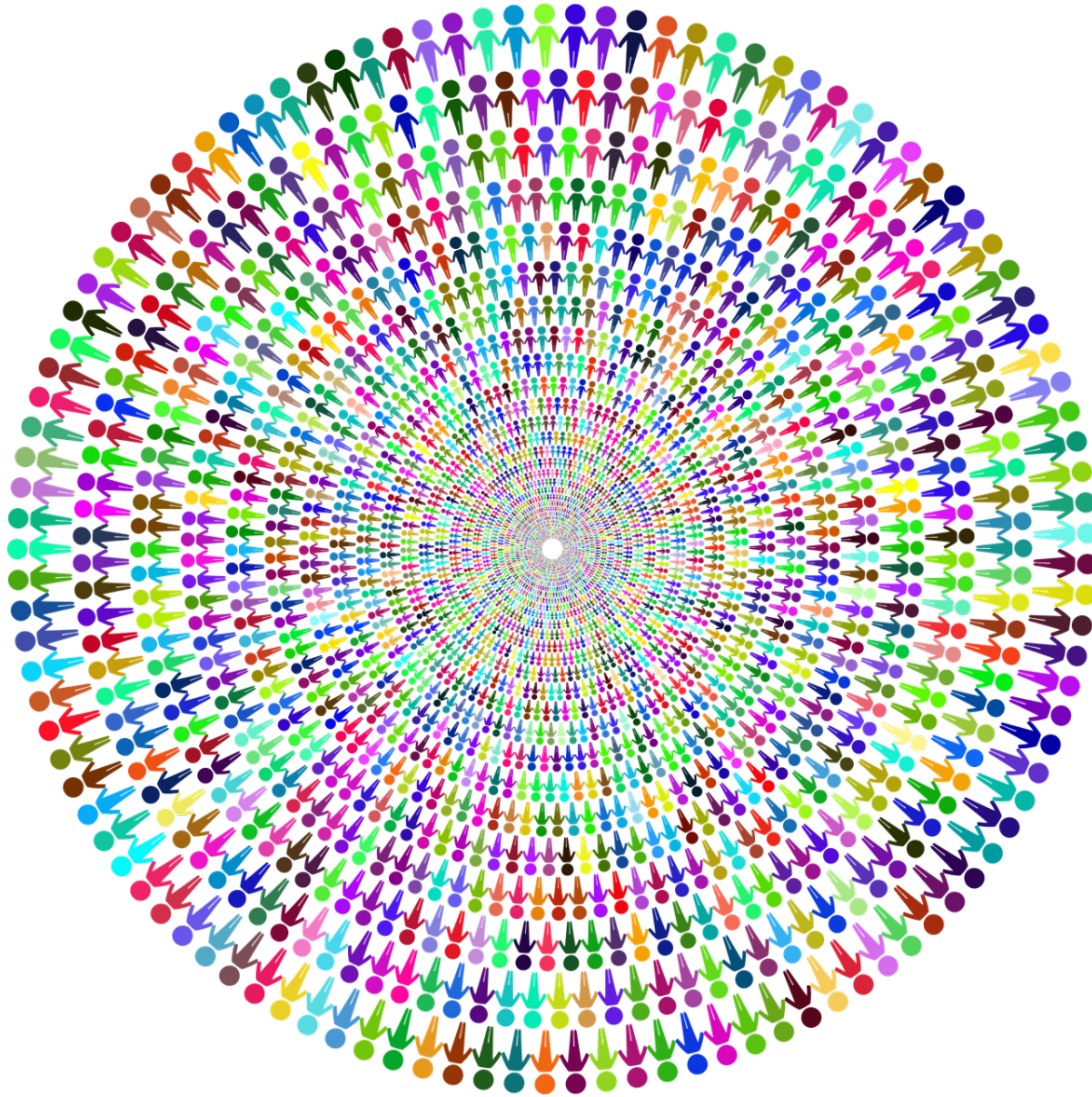
