 - For online classes, the new demographic survey will not be available until **October 5th** with PEARS switch-over






FFY 2023 Results for 8 Evaluation Surveys Already Analyzed & Saved in Box

- Eating and Activity Tool for Students (EATS) matched pre-posts n=1,500 from 15 Counties
- Teacher Observation Tool (TOT) n=401, from 18 Counties
- Physical Activity Teacher Observation Tool (PA-TOT) n=10, from 4 Counties
- Large Group Taste Test Tool (LG-TTT) n=194, from 12 Counties
- YPAR Retrospective Survey n=142 from 6 Counties
- YPAR Project Assessment n=84 from 2 Counties
- Teens as Teachers Survey n=25 from 3 Counties
- Youth Leader Survey n=43 from 1 County
